As a Journeyman Business Analyst, you will provide essential support to the United States Space Force's (USSF) Operational Test and Training Infrastructure (OTTI) Integrated Program Office (IPO). The OTTI program underpins force readiness by aligning the acquisition, development, and sustainment of long-term test and training capabilities for the USSF.

In this role, you will work closely with government leadership to drive strategic support, ensure operational efficiency, oversee workflow and business processes, and facilitate effective communication across the organization. Strong professional experience is required, and familiarity with the USSF, Space Systems Command (SSC), and Space Training and Readiness Command (STARCOM) processes is highly desired. Leadership and collaboration skills are essential.
